NEM 2.0 applies to residential and small business customers who received permission to operate on or after July 1, 2017 and applied for interconnection prior to April 15, 2023.

Your Account Summary

NEM 2.0 ABO Monthly with Charges

- Shows your current monthly non-energy charges (the minimum amount due for set-fees), and the due date.
- Shows your year-to-date net-energy charges, and the month in which any charges that are not offset by credits will be due on your annual settlement bill. To lower your energy charges, you may make additional payments at any time, and they will show as credits on your account summary. More information can be found on your annual bill.

NEM 2.0 ABO Monthly with Credits

- Provides details about your year-to-date charges (and whether you owe any), and your current billing month.
- In this example, additional payments have been made, and they show as credits on the account.
- The remaining unused energy credit (year-to-date energy credit) is zeroed out when the annual settlement bill is available.
- How do you receive credit? If you end the year with a negative balance (unused credit), and you're eligible to receive Net Surplus Compensation (NSC), it will be paid out as a bill credit or by check at the Net Surplus Compensation (NSC) rate (market rate).

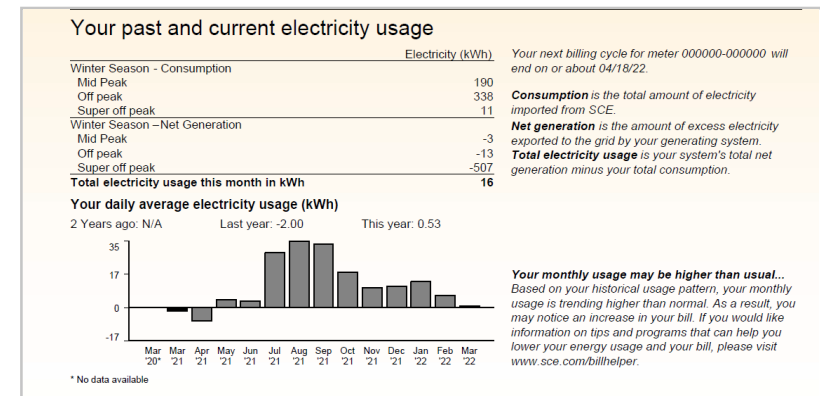
