



GET THE FACTS ABOUT A **FIXED CHARGE** ON ELECTRIC BILLS (STARTING IN LATE 2025)

FACT: THE FIXED CHARGE IS A CHANGE IN HOW RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS' ELECTRIC BILLS ARE CALCULATED.



FACT: It's not an additional fee. It will lower bills for many residential customers.*

** Assuming no increase in energy usage*



FACT: All residential customers would still pay energy charges based on usage but SCE rates would decrease by an average of 5-7 cents per kilowatt-hour.

FACT: CELL PHONE, WATER AND CABLE SERVICE BILLS ALL INCLUDE FIXED CHARGES.



HOW WOULD YOUR ELECTRIC BILL CHANGE?

A FIXED CHARGE that stays the same each month to cover costs of operating and maintaining the electric grid and providing customer support.

AN ENERGY CHARGE that varies each month based on how much electricity the customer used.

WHAT WON'T CHANGE

- **FACT:** Utilities will not make more profit from the fixed charge.
- **FACT:** Utilities won't need customers' household income data. Exception: CARE/FERA customers, who're already subject to income verification.

LOWER ELECTRICITY RATES (¢/KWH) FOR ALL RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS




LOWER FIXED CHARGE FOR CARE/FERA CUSTOMERS
