SCE and the CPUC invite you to public participation hearings to learn more about affordable energy options for your community.

The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) is exploring practical ways to bring natural gas or electricity options to residents of eligible communities in Stanislaus, Tulare, Fresno, Madera, and Merced counties. When natural gas is unavailable, analysis has shown customers burn wood or use propane for cooking as well as heating/cooling homes and water. Using natural gas or electricity instead can lower costs and it is safer for you, your family and community. These options are also cleaner for the environment.
