For comparison, the current average mix of resources supplying SCE includes: Coal (0%), Nuclear (8.3%), Biomass & Waste (0.1%), Geothermal (5.7%), Solar (17.0%), Wind (9.8%), Natural Gas (24.7%), Eligible Hydroelectric (0.5%), Large Hydroelectric (3.4%), Unspecified Sources (30.3%) and Other (0.1%). This resource mix was prepared in accordance with the SCE 2022 Power Content Label.
