

TIME OF USE – BASE INTERRUPTIBLE PROGRAM (TOU-BIP)

Roles and Responsibilities for the Installation of Remote Terminal Units

Southern California Edison (SCE) shall be responsible for:

- ✓ Providing notice of interruption, as well as the remote monitoring of the customer's load via the Remote Terminal Unit (RTU).
- ✓ Meeting with Customer to identify the best location for the RTU during the Initial Site Visit.
- ✓ Supplying the cable that will be used to connect the RTU to the customer's meter.
- ✓ Informing customer of their responsibilities during the installation and program interruptions, *i.e., customer installation of the RTU Cabinet, Cable/Conduit, and Uninterruptible Power Source to be completed within 30 calendar days; customer has 15 or 30 minutes (depending on Participation Option selected) to reduce to their FSL upon notification by SCE of an interruption event.*
- ✓ Providing maintenance of the RTU. An RTU manual will be left for customer during the Initial Site Visit.

The Customer shall be responsible for:

- ✓ Installing an Uninterruptible Power Source that is isolated from the electric load that is reduced during an interruption.
- ✓ Installing the conduit used for the cable that connects the RTU with the customer's meter within 30 calendar days.
- ✓ Installing the RTU cabinet where agreed upon during the Initial Site Visit within 30 calendar days.
- ✓ Becoming familiar with the obligations to perform during a BIP Interruption Event.
- ✓ Developing a written interruption Event Plan and reviewing with appropriate personnel.
- ✓ Installing a dedicated telephone line (*if required for the RTU*), and a separate dedicated telephone line to receive notice of interruption (*See TOU-BIP fact sheet for more information*).
