SUBJECT: Update of Public Utilities Commission Reimbursement Fee for
Fiscal Year 2005-06

In compliance with Resolution M-4816, Southern California Edison Company (SCE) hereby transmits for filing the following changes to its tariff schedules. The revised tariff sheets are listed on Attachment A and are attached hereto.

PURPOSE

This advice filing revises: (1) Schedule G-1, Santa Catalina Island – Domestic Service; (2) Schedule G-2, Santa Catalina Island – General Service; and (3) Schedule RF-G, Surcharge to Fund, Public Utilities Commission – Reimbursement Fee to reflect the updated Public Utilities Commission Reimbursement Fee (PUCRF) for fiscal year 2005-06.

BACKGROUND

Section 431 of the Public Utilities Code provides:

“The commission shall annually determine a fee to be paid by every electrical, gas, telephone, telegraph, water, sewer system, and heat corporation and every other public utility providing service directly to customers and subscribers and subject to the jurisdiction of the commission other than a railroad, except as provided in Article 2 (commencing with Section 421).”

On March 15, 2006, the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) issued Resolution M-4816, in which the Commission sets forth the levels of PUCRF for fiscal year 2005-06. The currently effective PUCRF of \$0.00000/per therm is increased to \$0.00076/per therm, effective April 1, 2006. This advice filing is made in compliance with Resolution M-4816.

This advice filing will increase rates for all retail customers, but will not cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any other schedule or rule.

No cost information is required for this advice filing.

EFFECTIVE DATE

In accordance with Resolution M-4816, the changes submitted in this advice filing will become effective on April 1, 2006.

2. Seasonal Service: For summer cottage customers and others who normally require service for only part of the year, this schedule is applicable only on an annual contract.
3. Baseline Service: The rates above are subject to Baseline Service provisions which are described in Part E of the Preliminary Statement. The applicable baseline quantity of gas to be billed under rates designated as Applicable to Baseline Service shall be the total of any Medical Baseline Allocation permitted under Part E, Paragraph 4 of the Preliminary Statement, plus the applicable daily baseline allocation shown below by Season and Time Period.
