SUBJECT: Agreements For Infrastructure Improvement Project
Management With The United States Government, Under
General Services Administration And Basic Ordering
Agreement Guidelines

Southern California Edison Company (SCE) hereby transmits for filing the following changes in its tariff schedules. The new tariff sheets are listed on Attachment A and are attached hereto.

PURPOSE

This advice filing revises SCE's List of Contracts and Deviations with agreements for infrastructure improvement project management with the United States Government (Government), General Services Administration (GSA), and the United States Navy (USN).

BACKGROUND

SCE hereby submits an original and five copies of two separate agreements (Agreements). The first agreement, between SCE and the GSA, is the Areawide Public Utility Contract for Electric, Electric Transmission, and Energy Related Services, identified as Contract No. GS-OOP-97-BSD-0058. The second agreement, between SCE and the USN, is the Basic Ordering Agreement (BOA), and is identified as agreement No. N68711-98-G-5931. SCE will revise its electric List of Contracts and Deviations to reflect the addition of each of these agreements.

The provisions of all subsequent contracts applicable to and authorized under the GSA Agreement and the BOA, will be entered into to perform various utility

services on local military bases within SCE's service territory under the provisions of Executive Order 12902 dated March 8, 1994, Sections 101-105, by authority of the President of the United States.

Under Executive Order 12902, the Government is authorized and encouraged to enter into contracts with local utilities on a established source basis to expedite and facilitate the implementation of cost effective energy and water conservation measures. It requires all federal facilities to implement measures that will significantly reduce their energy consumption, and as a result improves their operational effectiveness. Additionally, this Executive Order does not preclude the Government from seeking these services from other providers.

SCE has been asked by branches of the Department of Defense and the GSA to perform the work outlined in these Agreements. To demonstrate price reasonableness, SCE is directed by the Government to competitively bid all subcontractor work to energy service companies. This requirement for competitive sub-contracting stimulates competition in the energy services market by giving smaller energy services companies, who would not ordinarily have an opportunity to participate in this market, an opportunity to do so. This will maintain a fair and balanced opportunity for all players in the market to compete for projects of this kind, and to ensure that the Federal Government customers receive the most competitive bids for these services.

Absent SCE's assistance, the projects specified under the agreements would be subject to significant delay or potential cancellation, jeopardizing appropriated funding. SCE will not fund the work to be performed under these Agreements with Public Purpose Programs funding, nor Demand Side Management (DSM) funding from 1998 or prior DSM program years. SCE will book any resulting revenues from these contracts to Other Operating Revenues.

The contract provisions generally adhere to SCE's standard contract language and tariff requirements, with the exception of specifically required Federal Contract Language.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section X.B. of General Order 96-A, SCE hereby submits Contract No. GS-OOP-97-BSD-0058, and Agreement No. N68711-96-G-5931 for inclusion in its List of Contracts and Deviations.

No cost information is required for this advice filing.

This advice filing will not increase or decrease any rate or charge, conflict with any schedules or rules, nor cause the withdrawal of service.

EFFECTIVE DATE

It is requested that this advice filing become effective on the 40th calendar day after the date filed, February 1, 1999. No Resolution is required for approval of this advice filing.
