**SUBJECT:** E-Tables Reflecting the Determinations Made in Decision  
99-06-052 on the 1998 Annual Earnings Assessment  
Proceeding

**PURPOSE**

Southern California Edison Company (SCE) hereby submits this advice filing, providing E-tables in accordance with the Protocols and Procedures for the Verification of Costs, Benefits, and Shareholder Earnings from Demand-Side Management Programs (Protocols), as adopted by the Decision 99-06-052 (D.99-06-052).

**BACKGROUND**

On May 1, 1998, SCE filed Application 98-05-013 (Application), in the 1998 Annual Earnings Assessment Proceeding (AEAP). This Application contained incentive claims resulting from the Demand-Side Management (DSM) Programs offered in 1996 and 1997. In its Application, SCE requested that the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) approve DSM shareholder program incentive amounts of: (1) \$21.897 million for the 1997 Earnings Claim and (2) \$14.298 million for the 1996 Earnings Claim. The amount of earnings which would be collected for 1999 would be \$8.310 million, consisting of: (1) the 1997 Earnings Claim first installment of \$5.474 million and (2) the 1996 second year installment of \$2.836 million.

Following the submittal of party comments, SCE agreed with the Commission's Office of Ratepayer Advocates (ORA) to a settlement of \$2.184 million for the 1996 second year installment. There was no dispute on the 1997 earnings claim first installment. The Commission adopted the amounts settled to between SCE and the ORA.

Attachments A and B reflect the amounts for the 1996 program year earnings claim and the 1997 program year earnings claim, respectively.

**EFFECTIVE DATE**

This advice filing is made in compliance with D.99-06-052. No resolution is required for this advice filing; therefore, approval of this item is not subject to the review and comment provisions of Senate Bill 779. SCE requests that this advice filing become effective on the 40<sup>th</sup> calendar day after the date filed, which is August 21, 1999.
