SUBJECT: Revisions to Reflect the New Location of the National
Weather Service Site

Southern California Edison Company (SCE) hereby transmits for filing the following changes in its tariff schedules. The revised tariff sheets are listed on Attachment A and are attached hereto.

PURPOSE

This advice filing revises SCE's tariffs to reflect a change in location of the National Weather Service (NWS) site from the Los Angeles Civic Center to a site at the University of Southern California (USC).

BACKGROUND

The temperature recorded at the NWS site previously located in the Los Angeles Civic Center is used in the calculation of the charges for SCE's Real Time Pricing (RTP) rate schedules. The specific NWS site location is contained in the tariff language of the RTP rate schedules. In addition, reference to this site is made in various filed forms (Real Time Pricing Schedule RTP-2 Participation Agreement, Form 14-318, Agricultural and Pumping Real Time Pricing Schedule PA-RTP Participation Agreement, Form 16-324, Real Time Pricing Interruptible Schedule RTP-2-I Participation Agreement, Form 16-325).

INFORMATION

This advice letter revises the above schedules and filed forms to reflect this change. As of June 24, 1999, the NWS site has moved from the Los Angeles Civic Center to a site at USC and has been designated "Los Angeles downtown" resulting in the need for the tariff changes established by this advice filing.

No cost information is required for this advice filing.

This advice filing will not increase any rate of charge, cause withdrawal of service, or conflict with any rate schedule or rule.

EFFECTIVE DATE

It is requested that this advice filing become effective on the 40th calendar day after the day filed, which is September 22, 1999. No resolution is required for this filing; therefore, approval of this item is not subject to the review and comment provisions of Senate Bill 779.

There are no restrictions on who may file a protest, but the protest shall set forth specifically the grounds upon which it is based and shall be submitted expeditiously.

Further, in accordance with Public Utilities Code Section 491, notice to the public is hereby given by filing and keeping the advice filing open for public inspection at SCE's corporate headquarters.

REAL TIME PRICING
SCHEDULE RTP-2
PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

This Agreement is entered into between the Southern California Edison Company ("SCE") and

1. SCE Agrees to:

- 1.1 Sell and deliver to Customer electric service for the operation of Customer's electrical machinery and apparatus now or hereafter upon Customer premises located at _____ in accordance with SCE's Rate Schedule RTP-2, General Service - Large Real Time Pricing ("RTP") on file with the California Public Utilities Commission ("Commission"), as such schedule now exists or may hereafter be amended or superseded, copies of which are attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein;
- 1.2 Provide, install, own and maintain the special metering equipment to monitor Customer's electricity usage patterns ("Monitoring Equipment"). The RTP-2 Equipment and Monitoring shall be referred to collectively as the "Equipment"; and
- 1.3 Remove the Equipment and repair any damage to Customer's premises resulting from the installation of the Equipment, at SCE's expense, upon termination of Customer's participation in the RTP-2 program.

2. Customer Agrees to:

- 2.1 Participate in the RTP-2 program for a minimum of one year;
- 2.2 Provide a place acceptable to SCE upon Customer's premises for installation of the Equipment;
- 2.3 Respond to all survey questionnaires presented by SCE regarding customer attitudes, changes in Customer's end use, and/or overall operation in response to RTP-2 rates;
- 2.4 Provide SCE with access to the Customer's premises at all reasonable hours for any purpose connected with the RTP-2 program;
- 2.5 Allow SCE to remove the Equipment at the conclusion of Customer's participation in the RTP-2 program; and
- 2.6 Note the daily maximum temperature of its Los Angeles Downtown site as recorded by the National Weather Service and use this maximum temperature to determine the RTP-2 hourly rates for the following day according to the RTP-2 rate schedule.

3. Indemnity:

Customer shall, at its own cost and expense, defend, indemnify, and hold harmless SCE, its officers, agents, employees, assigns, and successors in interest, from and against any and all liability, damages, losses, claims, demands, actions, cause of action, costs, including attorney's fees and expenses, or any of them, resulting from the death or injury to any person or damage to any property caused by Customer, its employees, officers and agents, or any of them, and arising out of the performance or non-performance of its obligations under this Agreement.

4. Term:

The term of this Agreement shall be for a minimum of twelve months from the date service is first provided to Customer under Schedule RTP-2.

5. Renewal:

This Agreement will automatically be renewed at the end of each 12-month period. After the initial 12-month period, the customer may terminate service under this schedule upon not less than 30 days written notice to the Company.

6. Termination:

SCE reserves the right to terminate any Customer participation in the RTP-2 program at any time, when, in SCE's sole opinion, Customer is in non-compliance with the terms and conditions set forth herein.

7. California Public Utilities Commission:

7.1 This Agreement shall at all times be subject to such changes or modifications by the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California, as such Commission may, from time to time, direct in the exercise of its jurisdiction.

7.2 Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Agreement, SCE has the right to unilaterally file with the Public Utilities Commission, pursuant to the Commission's rules and regulations, an application for a change in rates, charges, classification, service, or rule, or any agreement relating thereto.
