**SUBJECT: Revisions to Reflect Change in Tariff from Blended
Propane/Butane Mixture to a Propane/Air Gas Mixture**

Southern California Edison Company (SCE) hereby submits for filing the following changes to its tariff schedules. The revised tariff sheets are listed on Attachment A and attached hereto.

PURPOSE

This advice filing modifies SCE Rule 2, Description of Service to reflect the transition in gas operations on Santa Catalina Island (Catalina) from a blended propane/butane mixture to a propane/air gas mixture system. This transition took place during the period of August 2004 through January 2005, but SCE only recently realized that a change to Rule 2 is necessary to make it consistent with this practice.

BACKGROUND

Decision 04-12-018 authorized SCE in its Catalina Gas Rate Case filed January 23, 2004 to increase its Catalina gas distribution base rate revenue requirement and to phase in that increase over a three-year period beginning in 2005. During hearings in that proceeding, the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) addressed the issue of whether the Commission would continue to have jurisdiction over SCE's gas operations on Catalina, since SCE had undergone a conversion of its gas plant from blended propane/butane liquefied gas to all-propane gas.¹

The Commission subsequently concluded that SCE's Catalina gas service is distinguishable from other propane operations since the gas plant could be converted back to a propane mix if prices or other conditions warranted, and therefore the

¹ Propane facilities do not fall within the definition of "Gas plant" under Public Utilities Code Section 221, and would otherwise be excluded from Commission jurisdiction.

Commission found that it continued to have jurisdiction over SCE's gas service on Catalina Island.

The transition from the blended propane/butane mixture to the propane/air gas mixture took place between August 2004 and January 2005. Accordingly, SCE is revising its Rule 2 to indicate that propane/air gas is now the gas supplied. Along with this change, the heating value of the gas increased from approximately 1,100 British Thermal Units (Btu) per cubic foot to approximately 1,300 Btu per cubic foot. In addition, several minor text revisions have been made to Rule 2 to change "the utility" reference to "SCE".

The revisions to Rule 2 reflect the transition to an all-propane gas system and change in heating value of the gas.

No cost information is required for this advice filing.

This advice filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any other schedule or rule.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This advice filing will become effective on the 30th calendar day after the date filed, which is July 29, 2007.

DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE

Sheet 1

A. Kind and Heating Value

The gas supplied by SCE is mixed propane/air gas of a heating value of approximately 1300 (T)
 British Thermal Units (Btu) per cubic foot. (T)

B. Pressure - General Service

The standard pressure of gas as measured at the outlet of the service meters installed on customers' premises is 8 inches of water column.

When gas is metered at low pressure the number of cubic feet so measured, without correction for pressure or temperature, is the quantity to which the rate schedules are applied.

Gas will be supplied at "high pressure" subject to the approval of SCE, when and where (T)
 such service is available from existing high pressure mains. Such "high pressure" service (T)
 shall be subject to change at any time at the option of SCE.

Where gas is metered at "high pressure," the number of cubic feet as actually metered, (T)
 corrected to absolute pressure of 14.73 pounds per square inch, is the quantity to which the (T)
 right schedules are applicable.
