SUBJECT: Modifications to Schedule WTR, Wireless Technologies Rate

Southern California Edison Company (SCE) hereby transmits for filing the following changes to its tariff schedules. The revised tariff sheets are listed on Attachment A and are attached hereto.

PURPOSE

This advice filing supplements Advice 1422-E, in its entirety to remove previously proposed corrections to Schedule WTR. This supplemental advice filing revises Schedule WTR to its original form as approved in Decision No. 99-11-054 (D.99-11-054).

BACKGROUND

On December 8, 1999, SCE filed Advice 1422-E to comply with D.99-11-054, dated November 18, 1999. D.99-11-054 approved, as filed in SCE's Rate Design Window proposal Application 99-01-021 (A.99-01-021), the following new tariffs and tariff revisions: 1) Schedule GS-FR, General Service-Flat Rate; 2) Schedule WTR, Wireless Technologies Rate; and 3) a revision to an existing tariff schedule, Schedule TOU-PA-5.

In addition to complying with D.99-11-054, SCE also submitted in Advice 1422-E, the following corrections to modify Schedule WTR:

- Special Condition 3, Three-Phase Service, was corrected to clarify that the billing for three phase service will be increased by \$0.079 *per device* per day. This Special Condition of the previously submitted Schedule WTR incorrectly provided that the billing for three phase service will be increased by \$0.079 *per customer* per day. The table in the Rates Components section was additionally modified to reflect this correction.
- The table in the Rates Components section was modified to remove the Devers Palo Verde Surcharge column and to include this charge in the same column as the Transmission Revenue Balancing Account Adjustment, as was approved in Resolution E-3547, on April 1, 1999, for all rate schedules. This change was inadvertently omitted from the previously submitted Schedule WTR.
- Additionally, a minor correction was made to the Application And Contract For Electric Service For Experimental Schedule WTR, Wireless Technology Rate, Form 14-687, Section 2, to replace 150 kWh with 151 kWh which will make it consistent with the same information on Schedule WTR.

Energy Division requested that SCE file a supplemental advice letter to remove these corrections and return the tariffs back to their original form as filed in A.99-01-021 and adopted in D.99-11-054. These three minor modifications will be addressed in a separate advice filing.

No cost information is required for this advice filing.

This advice filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any rate schedules or rules. No resolution is required for the approval of this advice letter.

EFFECTIVE DATE

Pursuant to D.99-11-054 and consistent with Advice 1422-E, the tariffs requested in this advice filing shall become effective on December 8, 1999.
