**SUBJECT:** Addition of Delano Energy Company, Inc. to the List of  
Contracts and Deviations

In compliance with the California Public Utilities Commission Resolution E-3645, Southern California Edison Company (SCE) hereby submits for filing the following changes to its tariff schedules. The revised tariff sheets are listed on Attachment A and are attached hereto.

**PURPOSE**

This advice filing revises SCE's List of Contracts and Deviations to include the Contract Termination Agreement (Agreement) as authorized in Resolution E-3645.

**BACKGROUND**

SCE filed Advice 1390-E on July 7, 1999, requesting a Commission Resolution approving the Agreement between SCE and Delano Energy Company, Inc. (Delano), a qualifying facility or QF, and finding it to be reasonable. The Agreement provides for:

- Termination of the Amended and Restated Power Purchase Contract (Contract) between SCE and Delano on December 31, 1999, instead of September 3, 2020, as specified in the Contract; and
- Payments to Delano for the early termination of the contract.

On November 4, 1999, the Commission issued Resolution E-3645 which approved Advice 1390-E. Additionally, Ordering Paragraph 2 of Resolution E-3645 authorizes SCE to revise its List of Contracts and Deviations to include the Agreement as ordered by the resolution.

No cost information is required for this advice filing.

This advice filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any other schedule or rule.

**EFFECTIVE DATE**

In compliance with Resolution E-3645, SCE requests that this advice filing become effective on the 40<sup>th</sup> calendar day after the day filed, which is February 6, 2000. No resolution is required for this advice filing; therefore, approval of this item is not subject to the review and comment provisions of Senate Bill 779.

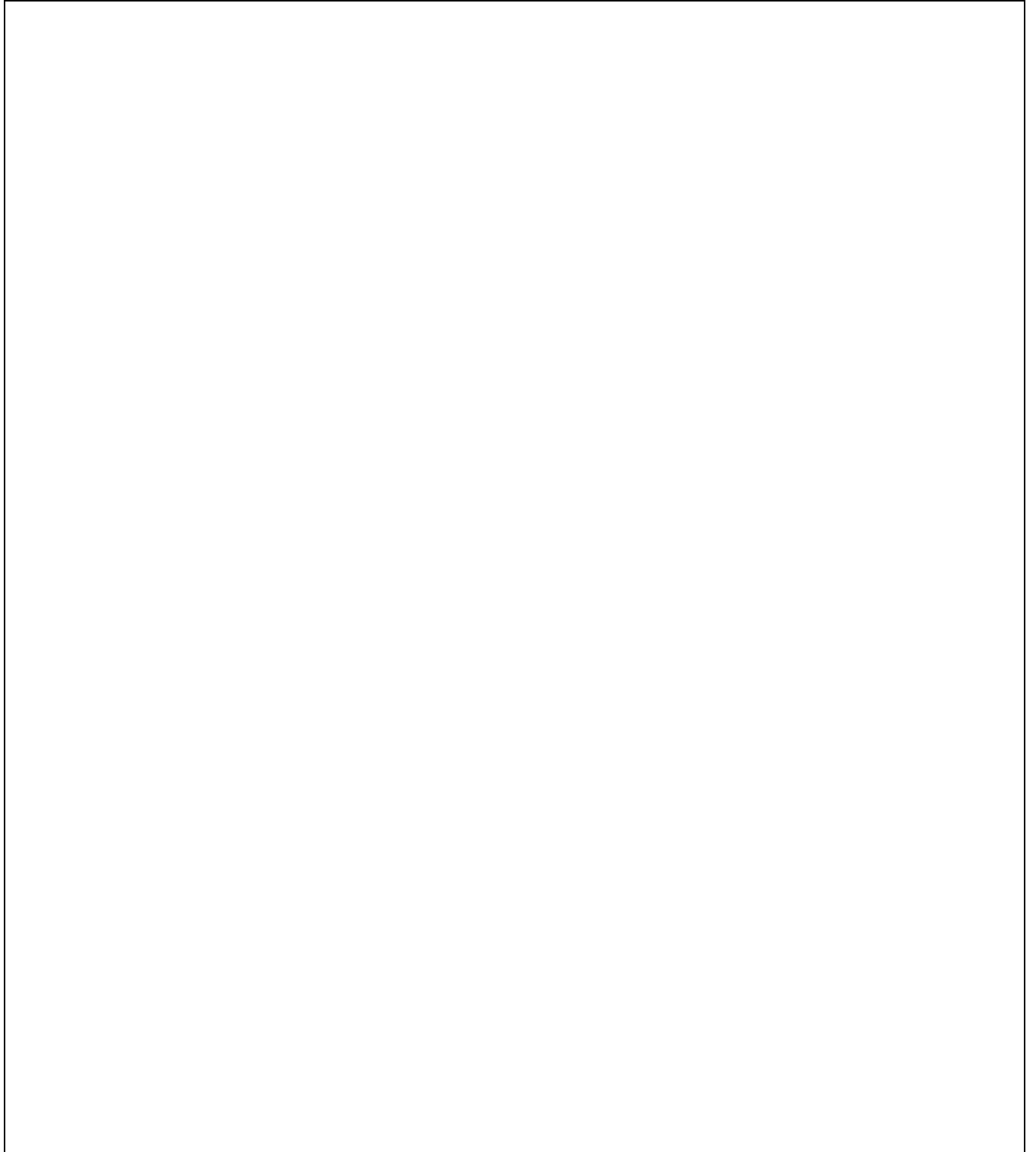
