**ADVICE 1462-E**  
**(U 338-E)**

PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

**SUBJECT:**     **Establishment of Form C-200**

Southern California Edison Company (SCE) hereby submits for filing the following changes to its tariff schedules. The revised tariff sheets are listed on Attachment A and are attached hereto.

**PURPOSE**

This advice filing establishes Form C-200, Assignment of Contract for Extension of Lines or Installation of Electric Facilities.

**BACKGROUND**

SCE filed Advice 197-E on August 29, 1946 to establish Form C-100, Assignment of Advance Payment of Extension of Lines or Installation of Electric Facilities. The intent of Form C-100 was to: (1) secure the extension of SCE's electric lines and/or the installation of SCE's electric facilities to serve the premises by entering into an agreement whereby an advance payment was made to SCE; (2) contractually account for the customer's assignment and transfer of all rights, title, and interest in and to any and all moneys on deposit with SCE, to a separate person or entity; and (3) record the amount of moneys advanced or deposited with SCE which have not been heretofore refunded to customers associated with a specific extension project in accordance with SCE's Rule 15, Distribution Line Extension.

On June 9, 1999, SCE filed Advice 1383-E to withdraw Form C-100. Form C-100 was last revised in 1972 and through its evolution in recent California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) proceedings in Order Instituting Rulemaking 92-03-050, SCE determined that Form C-100 has become outdated. In addition, Form C-100 was difficult to understand, did not reflect current pricing or billing

methodologies, and was being used solely for Applicant Installation projects, yet it was never intended for this purpose.

SCE's newly established Form C-200 is similar to Form C-100 in that it addresses a distribution line extension customer assigning and transferring all rights and obligations for the extension of SCE's electric lines and/or installation of SCE's electric facilities to a designated assignee. However, Form C-200 differs slightly from Form C-100 in content and use. Specifically Form C-200: (1) applies to SCE and Applicant Installations; (2) expressly conveys that the customer is entering an irrevocable assignment of contract for extension of lines or installation of electric facilities; (3) clearly emphasizes all contract obligations which include warranty and deficit billing if terms are not met; (4) communicates the obligation for possible payments owed to SCE pursuant to distribution line and service extensions in addition to any eligible refund amount; and (5) does not include an area within the form to record the amount of moneys advanced or deposited with SCE.

No cost information is required for this advice filing.

This advice filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any other schedule or rule.

### **EFFECTIVE DATE**

This advice filing will become effective on the 40<sup>th</sup> calendar day after the date filed, which is August 16, 2000.

There are no restrictions on who may file a protest, but the protest shall set forth

specifically the grounds upon which it is based and shall be submitted expeditiously.

**ASSIGNMENT OF CONTRACT FOR EXTENSION

NOW, THEREFORE, Customer does hereby irrevocably assign and transfer to Assignee all of Customer's rights and obligations under the Extension Agreement. As of \_\_\_\_\_ (date), Customer assigns all of its right, title and interest in and to payment of all moneys on record with SCE which have not been heretofore refunded ("Eligible Refund Amount"), and all of its obligations for payments owed to SCE pursuant to the Extension Agreement. Assignee hereby agrees to accept Customer's assignment of its rights and obligations under the Extension Agreement as set forth herein, and agrees to assume and comply with all of the terms and conditions of the Extension Agreement as of the effective date of this assignment.

Customer and Assignee hereby acknowledge that SCE has made no representations to them concerning the assignability of Customer's rights in the Extension Agreement.

This assignment shall not become effective until it has been signed by Customer and Assignee as provided below, and a representative of SCE.
