SUBJECT: Establishment of the Catalina Gas Operations GRC Revenue Requirement Memorandum Account in Compliance with Decision 09-01-011

In compliance with the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) Decision (D.) 09-01-011, Southern California Edison Company (SCE) hereby submits for filing the following changes to its tariff schedules. The revised tariff sheets are listed on Attachment A and are attached hereto.

PURPOSE

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 1 of D.09-01-011, this advice filing establishes the Catalina Gas Operations 2009 General Rate Case (GRC) Revenue Requirement Memorandum Account (GRC RRMA).

BACKGROUND

SCE filed its 2009 Catalina Gas Operations GRC Application (A.08-09-019) on September 23, 2008 requesting the Commission adopt a 2009 GRC revenue requirement for SCE of \$1.654 million.

On November 6, 2008, SCE requested authorization to establish a memorandum account to track the revenue requirement requested in this application during the period between January 1, 2009 and the effective date of a final decision in A.08-09-019. In D.09-01-011, the Commission granted this request and authorized SCE to establish a memorandum account to track the change in revenue requirement ultimately adopted in the 2009 Catalina Gas Operations GRC proceeding during the period between January 29, 2009 and the effective date of a final GRC decision.

**CATALINA GAS OPERATIONS GRC REVENUE REQUIREMENT MEMORANDUM
ACCOUNT**

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 1 of D.09-01-011, SCE is establishing the Catalina Gas Operations GRC RRMA to track the revenue requirement impact of the Commission's final decision in SCE's 2009 Catalina Gas Operations GRC proceeding during the period between January 29, 2009, and the effective date of a final decision in this GRC proceeding.

The Catalina Gas Operations GRC RRMA will track and determine the difference between: (1) the 2009 GRC revenue requirement ultimately approved by the Commission; and (2) the previously authorized GRC-related revenue requirement.

The operation of the Catalina Gas Operations GRC RRMA will be set forth in the compliance advice letter implementing the 2009 Catalina Gas Operations GRC decision.

TIER DESIGNATION

Pursuant to D.07-01-024, Appendix B, Energy Industry Rule 5.1(3), SCE believes this advice letter is subject to Energy Division disposition and should be classified as Tier 1 (effective pending disposition).

EFFECTIVE DATE

Pursuant to D.09-01-011, this advice filing is effective on January 29, 2009.

H. MEMORANDUM ACCOUNTS

1. Catalina Gas Operations GRC Revenue Requirement Memorandum Account
(Catalina Gas GRC RRMA)

a. Purpose

SCE is authorized to establish a memorandum account to track the revenue requirement that SCE has requested in its Catalina Gas Operations 2009 GRC Application (A.08-19-019) during the period between January 29, 2009, and the date a final decision is adopted in this proceeding with the prior authorized revenue requirement.

b. Operation of the Catalina Gas GRC RRMA

(1) An entry for SCE's currently authorized Catalina Gas Operations GRC-related revenue requirement shall be made each month. SCE's currently authorized annual Catalina Gas Operations GRC-related revenue requirement pursuant to D.04-12-018 is \$984,500;

(2) When the Commission authorizes a 2009 Catalina GRC Operations revenue requirement in A.08-09-019, that amount will be compared to the Catalina Gas Operations GRC-related revenue requirement from (1) above to determine the balance that will be either recovered from or returned to customers, upon Commission approval.

(3) An entry to remove the timing difference between the current level of service fees and the implementation date of the revised service fees. This entry will be calculated by taking the difference between (1) the annual service fee Other Operating Revenue (OOR) ultimately authorized in the 2009 Catalina Gas Operations GRC decision; and (2) the annual service fee OOR that is currently authorized.

Interest shall accrue to the Catalina Gas GRC RRMA by applying the Interest Rate to the average of the beginning and ending account balance.

c. Disposition of the Balance

Upon Commission approval, the Catalina Gas GRC RRMA balance shall be included in rate levels after the issuance of a final decision in D. 08-09-019.
