**SUBJECT:**     **Submission of Modified Short-Term Procurement Plan**  
                  **Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 6 of Decision 02-12-074**

**PURPOSE**

Southern California Edison Company (SCE) hereby submits its modified short-term procurement plan as required by Ordering Paragraph 6 of Decision (D.) 02-12-074 (Decision).

**BACKGROUND**

D.02-12-074 was issued in Order Instituting Rulemaking (OIR.) 01-10-024, to Establish Policies and Cost Recovery Mechanisms for Generation Procurement and Renewable Resource Development. The Decision, among other things, approved the updated short-term procurement plans, with certain modifications, submitted by SCE, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E), and San Diego Gas and Electric (SDG&E) in November 2002. The Decision also puts in place upfront standards and practices under which each utility must conduct its procurement activities.<sup>1</sup>

Ordering Paragraph 6 of the Decision requires SCE to to update its November 2002 procurement plan within 18 calendar days of the effective date of the Decision to reflect the final disposition of transitional procurement contracts approved by the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) pursuant to D.02-08-071, and

certain changes to SCE's procurement plan set forth in Confidential Appendix B to the Decision.<sup>2</sup>

On January, 7, 2003, SCE submitted Advice 1660-E-A to the Commission for approval of SCE's proposed transitional electric capacity procurement contracts in compliance with Resolution E-3802 and associated December 2002 confidential transmissions from the Energy Division. The compliance filing submitted for Commission review and approval, the refreshed contract orders, bid analyses and executed contracts that resulted from the SCE bid refresh process conducted pursuant to the pre-approval provided in Resolution E-3802.

This compliance filing submits SCE's modified short-term procurement plan, consistent with Advice 1660-E-A, SCE's transitional procurement contracts submittal, and Confidential Appendix B of D.02-12-074.

All attachments to this advice letter contain Confidential Protected Material subject to the protections in the May 1, 2002, Protective Order issued in OIR 01-10-024, and pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 583.<sup>3</sup>
