PURPOSE

This advice filing requests the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) approve an amendment to Southern California Edison Company's (SCE) Modified Short-Term Procurement Plan Pursuant to Decision (D.) 02-10-062 (2003 Modified Procurement Plan) to add additional authorized brokerages/exchanges. The 2003 Modified Procurement Plan has been revised to reflect the addition of the identified brokerages/exchanges for approval.

BACKGROUND

In the short term procurement plan SCE stated that it "anticipates using different methods to execute transactions depending on product requirements and prevailing market conditions. SCE proposes to select appropriate method(s) depending on the transaction contemplated to ensure that transaction prices are competitive. If SCE determines that use of additional transaction methods and/or brokerages/exchanges would be beneficial during the term of the procurement plan SCE will propose such methods via the advice letter process." (Confidential version of the 2003 Modified Procurement Plan, page 124).
