PURPOSE

Southern California Edison Company (“SCE”) submits this Supplement to Advice Letter 1909-E. This Supplement, in part, to Advice 1909-E, is for the purpose of submitting (i) an additional confidential portion of the power purchase agreement, which SCE inadvertently failed to include in its original filing of Advice Letter 1909-E, and (ii) a confidential notice and request for limited waiver in respect to the power purchase agreement between SCE and Stirling Energy Systems, Inc. SCE seeks to include the attached supplemental information as Exhibits B-4, B-5 and B-6 to Confidential Appendix B to Advice Letter 1909-E.

Confidential Exhibits B-4, B-5 and B-6 to Appendix B are “Confidential Protected Materials” within the meaning of the protective order issued in May 2003 in R.01-10-024 (“Protective Order”) and, therefore, should be treated in accordance with the provisions of the Protective Order, Pub.
