SUBJECT: Notice of Grant of Easement to Brian and Cheryl Ford; A. 05-03-017, D. 05-11-023

PURPOSE

This informational advice filing is made pursuant to Decision (D.) 05-11-023 to report that Southern California Edison Company (SCE) is issuing a grant of Easement to Brian and Cheryl Ford on lands associated with the SCE Kaweah Hydroelectric Project.

BACKGROUND

On March 16, 2005, SCE filed Application No. 05-03-017 with the Commission pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 851. The Application requested Commission approval for SCE to grant an easement to Brian and Cheryl Ford for the use of 3,383 square feet of utility property (the "Site") on land within the Kaweah Hydroelectric Project.

In 1987, the Fords purchased a parcel of land with a single-family residence adjacent to the Site, and have since used the Site for limited parking and recreational use, as they believed that the Site was part of the purchased property. Following a survey, SCE discovered that the Site was utility property. A dispute between SCE and the Fords then arose as to the Fords' right to use the property. SCE and the Fords entered into an agreement whereby, subject to Commission approval, SCE would grant the Fords an easement for the use of the Site. The Fords will pay SCE \$1,050, the fair market value for the easement.

On November 18, 2005, the Commission issued D.05-11-023 authorizing SCE to grant an easement to the Fords. The Commission Decision ordered SCE to file an advice letter within 30 days of issuing the grant providing notice of the completed transfer. SCE sent the grant of easement to the Fords for signature on January 17th. The Fords accepted the easement on January 23rd. Thus, the grant of easement to the Fords,

which will be recorded shortly, is effective as of January 23, 2006, requiring that this Advice Letter be filed with the Commission by February 22, 2006.

This advice filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any other schedule or rule.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This informational advice filing is made pursuant to D.05-11-023 and is effective upon filing.
