SUBJECT: Supplemental Advice Letter Filing of Southern California Edison Company Concerning June Month-Ahead and Year-Ahead Resource Adequacy Compliance Filings for Compliance Year 2006

Southern California Edison Company (SCE) hereby submits this Supplemental Advice Letter containing corrections to its June 2006 month-ahead and conforming corrections to its year-ahead resource adequacy (RA) Compliance Filings for Compliance Year 2006. SCE's submission includes a completed RA Reporting Workbook for the June 2006 month-ahead RA compliance filing and RA Reporting Workbooks for the June, July, August and September 2006 year-ahead compliance filings. In addition, the filing contains attachments that support SCE's response to questions raised by the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) Energy Division staff in reviewing SCE's June 2006 month-ahead RA compliance filing. This filing includes hard copies and a compact disc containing electronic filings of each workbook. All of the materials attached to this advice letter are protected materials pursuant to the Administrative Law Judge's Ruling Adopting Revised Protective Order in Rulemaking 05-12-013, dated February 10, 2006, General Order 66-C, and Public Utilities Code Section 583.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Supplemental Advice Letter is to provide the Commission with corrections to SCE's June month-ahead and year-ahead RA Compliance filings for 2006, respond to questions raised by the Commission's Energy Division staff regarding that compliance filing, and request the Commission to confirm that SCE has met its June month-ahead and year-ahead RA obligation for compliance year 2006.

BACKGROUND

On May 1, 2006, SCE submitted its month-ahead RA Compliance filing for June 2006 (Advice 1995-E). Subsequent to that filing, SCE was contacted by the Commission's Energy Division and asked to respond to several questions associated with SCE's filing. On May 23, 2006, SCE submitted corrections to its June 2006 month-ahead RA compliance filing (Advice 1995-E-A). On June 16, 2006, Commission's Energy Division sent an e-mail request to SCE and asked that we respond to several questions associated with their review of SCE's compliance filing. In order to address two of the Energy Division's questions, SCE had to submit revised RA Workbooks for the June month-ahead and year-ahead RA compliance filings for compliance year 2006. Those revisions, along with the response to all of the Energy Division's questions, are provided with this Supplemental Advice Letter.

EFFECTIVE DATE

SCE requests the Commission to confirm by July 28, 2006, that SCE has satisfactorily responded to the Energy Division's questions and that SCE has met its June month-ahead and year-ahead RA requirement for compliance year 2006.
