PURPOSE

The purpose of this advice filing is to supplement Advice 2143-E in order to withdraw the request of Southern California Edison Company ("SCE") for approval of the renewables portfolio standard ("RPS") power purchase agreement ("PPA") between SCE and Baja Wind US LLC (the "Baja Wind Contract").

BACKGROUND

Advice 2143-E was filed on July 27, 2007 to request approval of four RPS PPAs which resulted from SCE's 2006 RPS solicitation: (1) the Baja Wind Contract; (2) the PPA between SCE and Granite Wind, LLC (the "Granite Wind Contract"); (3) the PPA between SCE and California Sunrise I: Alternative Energy Development LLC (the "California Sunrise Contract"); and (4) the PPA between SCE and County Sanitation Districts of Los Angeles County (the "LACSD Contract"). On August 16, 2007, SCE supplemented Advice 2143-E by filing Advice 2143-E-A in order to include the Independent Evaluation Report for SCE's 2006 Renewable Resource Solicitation. On January 1, 2008, SCE filed Advice 2143-E-B to supplement Advice 2143-E and Advice 2143-E-A in order to reflect changes made to the standard terms and conditions decision.

The Granite Wind Contract, the California Sunrise Contract, and the LACSD Contract were approved by the California Public Utilities Commission (the "Commission") in Resolutions E-4125 and E-4168. With respect to the Baja Wind Contract, SCE requires additional time to prepare and present material relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. For this reason, SCE hereby requests that its request made pursuant to Advice 2143-E, 2143-E-A, and 2143-E-B for approval of the Baja Wind Contract be withdrawn.

TIER DESIGNATION

Pursuant to D.07-01-024, Energy Industry Rule 5.3, SCE submits this advice filing with a Tier 2 designation (effective after Commission approval).

EFFECTIVE DATE

SCE requests that this advice filing become effective on August 26, 2008, subject to review and approval by the Commission.

PROTESTS

SCE asks that the Commission maintain the original protest and comment period as designated in Advice 2143-E, filed on July 27, 2007, because this supplemental advice filing is simply requesting withdrawal of SCE's request for approval of the Baja Wind Contract.
