SUBJECT: Report of Purchase of Existing Meters by Customers

PURPOSE

Southern California Edison Company (SCE) hereby notifies the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) that three of its customers have purchased their existing meters pursuant to Decision (D.)02-10-008.

BACKGROUND

On October 3, 2002, the Commission issued D.02-10-008 in the Matter of the Application of Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) Proposing Prices and Conditions for the Purchase by Customers of Their Existing Meters in Compliance with D.98-07-032 and D.99-11-008. D.02-10-008 approved a Settlement Agreement whereby PG&E, San Diego Gas & Electric Company and SCE may sell electric meters to their customers when both parties are in agreement to the term of the sale.

D.02-10-008 describes the conditions of the sale of utility-owned meters located at the customer's service location. It provides that "the proposed sale price for meters is the greater of the meter's net book value or the replacement cost new less depreciation."¹ Further, D.02-10-008 states that "after-tax proceeds from meter sales will be credited to the depreciation reserve, to ratepayers' benefit."² The California Environmental Quality Act will not apply to the "sales of existing meters where the sales price of each meter is

\$4,000 or less.”³ Additionally, D.02-10-008 provides that no Public Utilities Code § 851 filing will be necessary as a result of these sales.⁴

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 2 in D.02-10-008, SCE submits this advice filing to “[r]eport . . . sales of electric meters to customers.”⁵ Proceeds of the sale are listed below:

1. On February 25, 2010, SCE sold two 3-phase, 120/208V, 4W meters and one 3-phase, 277/480V, 4W meter for \$343.31.
2. On February 25, 2010, SCE sold five 3-phase, 120/208V, 4W meters and one 3-phase, 277/480V, 4W meter for \$859.05.
3. On March 31, 2010, SCE sold six 3-phase, 4W, 2.5A meters and one 3-phase, 2W, 2.5A meter for \$1,007.73.

This advice filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any other schedule or rule.

TIER DESIGNATION

Pursuant to General Order (GO) 96-B, Energy Industry Rule 5.1, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation. In addition, this informational advice letter is being filed in compliance with Ordering Paragraph 2 of D.02-10-008.

Section 6.10 of the Settlement Agreement approved in D.02-10-008 states:

For sales of existing meters with sale prices of \$4,000 or less, a single advice letter every six months listing the total number of completed sales, and the gairi [*sic*] on sales is acceptable in lieu of an advice letter for each sale.
