SUBJECT: Lifting of Phase 1 Water Rationing on Santa Catalina Island

In compliance with Rule 14.1- Santa Catalina Island Fresh Water Rationing Plan, Section 5 of General Information, Southern California Edison Company (SCE) hereby submits this advice filing lifting Phase 1 Water Rationing imposed on December 18, 2007.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this advice filing is to notify the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) of SCE's intent to lift Phase 1 Water Rationing on Santa Catalina Island that was imposed on December 18, 2007.

BACKGROUND

SCE's Santa Catalina Island Fresh Water Rationing Plan was first established by Resolution W-2122 and Advice 16-W in 1977, and was later modified by Decision 90-05-033 and Advice 43-W. Advice 74-W, approved on March 2, 2010, further updated SCE's Water Conservation and Rationing Plan to substantially conform it to Standard Practice U-40-W, Instructions for Water Conservation, Rationing and Service Connection Moratoria (Standard Practice U-40-W). Specifically, Advice 74-W updated Rule 14.1 - Santa Catalina Island Fresh Water Rationing Plan and Rule 20 - Water Conservation. It also established Schedule 14.1- Staged Mandatory Water Conservation and Rationing. Rule 14.1 provides that when water rationing is in effect under Schedule 14.1, SCE shall seek Commission approval via a Tier 1 advice filing to de-activate mandatory rationing when it determines that water supplies are again sufficient to meet normal demands and water rationing measures are no longer necessary.

SCE implemented Phase 1 Water Rationing on Santa Catalina Island on December 18, 2007. Recently, water levels have increased significantly, increasing in the Middle Ranch Reservoir from 342 Acre Feet on January 4, 2010 to 923 Acre Feet as of January 10, 2011. Thus, SCE has determined water supplies are again sufficient to meet normal demands and seeks approval to de-activate mandatory water rationing on Santa Catalina Island.

TIER DESIGNATION

Pursuant to General Order (GO) 96-B, Water Industry Rule 7.3.(1) and in conformance with Standard Practice U-40-W, this advice filing is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

EFFECTIVE DATE

SCE requests that this advice filing be effective upon filing.
