APPLICABILITY

Applicable to photovoltaic (PV) service for customers requesting service located in areas where a line extension is not economical. This schedule will be closed to new service (1) when the total installed PV systems exceed 1 MW for all customers, or (2) after May 16, 1997. The SCE has the sole right to determine the customer's eligibility for service under this schedule. (T)

TERRITORY

Within the entire territory served.

RATES

Monthly Charge:

The Monthly Charge for service under this schedule is currently equal to 1.6 percent times the total installed cost of the photovoltaic system. The Monthly Charge is due regardless of the amount of energy delivered. (T)

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. Photovoltaic System: The solar photovoltaic module array, the module array mounting structure, the control structure, the control equipment, necessary wiring, batteries and/or backup generator, if required, and any other equipment necessary to provide photovoltaic service. (T)
2. Contract: A 15 year contract is required prior to receiving service under this schedule. Service will not be provided on this schedule in excess of 15 years. Photovoltaic service may extend beyond 15 years by separate agreement between SCE and the customer. The contract may be terminated by either party upon 30 days notice. Upon termination of the contract, the customer may: (1) request that SCE remove the PV facility and pay SCE a removal charge, or (2) opt to purchase the PV facility at the lesser of its fair market value as determined by SCE, or SCE's original cost less accumulated depreciation. A Customer may not obtain photovoltaic service within 1 year following termination of service under this schedule. (T)

SPECIAL CONDITIONS (Continued)

3. Service Limitation: Electric service under this schedule is limited to that provided by the photovoltaic system. SCE is under no obligation to provide electric service to the customer being served under this schedule at any time by means of SCE's transmission or distribution system. (T)
4. Engineering/Administration Fee: Customer shall pay to SCE a fee of \$500 upon request for service under this schedule. Upon withdrawal of the customer's request for service prior to installation of any part of the Photovoltaic System, SCE shall refund \$250 of the Engineering/Administration Fee to the customer. Upon completion of the installation, the \$500 Engineering/Administration Fee will be credited toward the customer's monthly bill. (T)
5. Competitive Bidding: SCE will bid out the system and provide the customer with three lowest qualifying bids. However, if there are fewer than three bids submitted, SCE will present all qualifying bids to the customer. The customer will be provided with the phone numbers of the three lowest qualifying bids to further evaluate their bids. The customer will have 30 days to notify SCE of the customer's selection of a bid. The customer's failure to notify SCE within 30 days shall be considered to be withdrawal of the customer's request for service and SCE will refund \$250 of the Engineering/Administration Fee to the customer as specified above in Special Condition 4. (T)
6. Customer Designated Contractors: A customer may, at its option, designate a contractor without going through competitive bidding provided the customer has been informed of SCE's Competitive Bidding process. (T)
