ON-GRID PHOTOVOLTAIC SERVICE

Sheet 1

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to photovoltaic (PV) service for new or existing customers connected to the Utility's electrical system. The Utility has the sole right to determine the customer's eligibility for service under this schedule. This schedule will be closed to new customers as of January 1, 1998 or earlier if the total load served under this schedule exceeds 5 MW.

TERRITORY

Within the entire territory served.

RATES

The Monthly Charge for service under this schedule is currently equal to 1.6 percent times the total installed cost of the photovoltaic system. The Monthly Charge is due regardless of the amount of energy delivered.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. Photovoltaic System: The solar photovoltaic module array, the module array mounting structure, the control structure, any necessary wiring, and any other control equipment necessary to provide photovoltaic service.
2. Contract: A 15 year contract is required prior to receiving service under this schedule. Service will not be provided on this schedule in excess of 15 years. Photovoltaic service may extend beyond 15 years by separate agreement between Company and the customer. The customer may terminate service upon 30 days written notice to the Utility and subject to the termination provision of the contract.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS (Continued)

- 3. Engineering/Administration Fee: Customer shall pay to the Utility a fee of \$500 upon request for service under this schedule. Upon withdrawal of the customer's request for service prior to installation of any part of the Photovoltaic System, the Utility shall refund \$250 of the Engineering/Administration Fee to the customer. Upon completion of the installation, the \$500 Engineering/Administration Fee will be credited against the monthly charge reflected in the first month's bill.
- 4. The Utility will bid out the system and provide the customer with three lowest qualifying bids. However, if there are fewer than three bids submitted, the Utility will present all bids to the customer. Customers will have 30 days to notify the Utility of the customer's selection of a bid. The customer's failure to notify the Utility within 30 days shall be considered to be withdrawal of the customer's request for service and the Utility will refund \$250 of the Engineering/Administration Fee to the customer as specified above in Special Condition 3.
