

This appendix presents expected approvals, authorizations, and permits for the proposed Tehachapi Renewable Transmission Project.

Once the CPUC deems the TRTP Application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) complete, the CPUC and the ANF will engage in a joint California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)/National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process in accordance with applicable state and federal environmental regulations, policy, and law. One of the primary objectives of this CEQA/NEPA process is to ensure that the Project is consistent with applicable statutes, plans, policies, and other regulatory requirements. SCE will obtain in a routine manner the necessary governmental approvals, authorizations, and permits as required by federal, state, and local laws, regulations, and ordinances pursuant to the requirements specified under CPUC General Order 131-D. Table M-1 presents a list of these expected requirements.
