REGARDING THE CONFIDENTIALITY OF CERTAIN DATA

I, Bill Chiu, declare and state:

1. I am Managing Director of Grid Modernization and Resiliency at Southern California Edison (SCE). I was delegated authority to sign this declaration by Philip R. Herrington, senior vice president of Transmission and Distribution at SCE.
