Get the Benefits of SCE's E-Summary Billing for Multiple Accounts

Receive invoices more quickly, reduce or eliminate late fees, and ensure greater security with access to statements through a secure portal.

If you are already a summary-billed customer (meaning you have two or more service accounts on the same bill), you can elect to receive your monthly statements using **e-summary billing**. This service provides all monthly billing and energy usage information in one spreadsheet, sent each month via a secure SharePoint site.

E-summary billing provides a convenient option for customers with hundreds or thousands of service accounts – and you can enroll some or all of them. Additional features and benefits include:

- Receive prompt notification when statements are available.
- Eliminate lost or delayed receipt of statements.
- Identify statement details by line item and see billing corrections.
- View and download statements securely for six months.
- Lower your costs for document storage and shredding.
- Decrease paper waste and reduce your carbon footprint.

To enroll in e-summary billing, email *EDI@sce.com* with the following details for each recipient:

- Company/business partner name
- Requestor's first and last name and title
- List of contract account numbers to enroll
- Email address(es) for the monthly link
- Display name (how the recipient will be addressed in monthly messages)
