

# SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY

## APPLICANT DESIGN TERMS AND CONDITIONS

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### 1. PURPOSE

These Applicant Design Terms and Conditions ("Terms") establish the responsibilities, requirements, and conditions applicable when an Applicant elects to prepare, or contract for the preparation of, electric distribution designs for facilities to be owned and operated by Southern California Edison Company (SCE).

### 2. APPLICANT DESIGNER RESPONSIBILITIES

The Applicant Designer shall:

- 2.1 Prepare and submit all required design drawings and supporting documentation.
  - 2.2 Comply with all current SCE Design Standards and Drafting Standards.
  - 2.3 Comply with the SCE Applicant Design Approval Process.
  - 2.4 Comply with General Order 95, General Order 128, and all applicable state and local codes, statutes, regulations, and ordinances.
  - 2.5 Provide all required design data to SCE in a digital format acceptable to SCE.
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### 3. UTILITY RESPONSIBILITIES

SCE shall:

- 3.1 Provide current design standards and drafting standards applicable to the project.
  - 3.2 Provide project feed points (inventory maps) and circuit tie-ins (circuit maps), as applicable.
  - 3.3 Provide global facilities planning requirements, including but not limited to conductor size and type, conduit requirements, voltage and phase requirements, system isolation requirements, and material specifications.
  - 3.4 Perform accounting and cost estimating activities.
  - 3.5 Provide and administer required contracts and agreements.
  - 3.6 Provide the Applicant with a reproducible approved map and associated digital files upon final design approval.
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## 4. STREET IMPROVEMENTS

In assuming and performing the design of electric distribution facilities, the Applicant assumes responsibility for determining that the proposed locations of facilities to be owned and operated by SCE are acceptable and do not conflict with the Applicant's planned improvements or the requirements of the applicable permit-issuing agency.

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## 5. STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS

5.1 The Applicant Designer is responsible for complying with SCE's design standards as well as all applicable requirements of governing jurisdictions, including statutes, codes, regulations, ordinances, and permit requirements.

5.2 The Applicant Designer shall ensure that all design submittals meet SCE digital format requirements.

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## 6. APPLICANT DESIGN CREDIT

SCE may provide a credit toward the Applicant's payment for eligible design work performed by the Applicant or Applicant Designer, as determined by SCE and in accordance with applicable rules, tariffs, and agreements.

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## 7. PLAN CHECK

7.1 SCE is responsible for plan checking Applicant-prepared designs for compliance with SCE design and construction standards. The Applicant Designer remains responsible for compliance with all non-Utility codes, standards, regulations, and ordinances.

7.2 The first plan check will be performed by SCE at no charge to the Applicant. Subsequent plan checks may be subject to fees based on project-specific hourly rates.

7.3 Plan checks are generally performed within five (5) working days following submittal to the SCE Service Planner.

7.4 Digital format compliance reviews are generally performed within five (5) to fifteen (15) working days following acceptance by the SCE Service Planner.

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## 8. INDEMNIFICATION

The Applicant agrees that the indemnification provisions of the Contract for Extension of Electric Distribution Line, Rule No. 15, shall apply to all Applicant design work, whether such work is performed by the Applicant or by an Applicant Designer.

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
