Dear Ms. Reese:

On January 22, 2025, Southern California Edison (SCE) filed its Final License Application (FLA) for the Rush Creek Hydroelectric Project, Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) Project No. 1389. At the time of filing the FLA, implementation of the cultural (CUL 1 – Built Environment and CUL 2 – Archaeology) and Tribal (TRI 1 – Tribal Resources) resources Technical Study Reports (TSRs), and the Historic Properties Management Plan (HPMP), were ongoing. Therefore, FLA Volume V, intended to contain these documents, was filed as a placeholder.

The following cultural and Tribal TSRs are now complete and are being filed as privileged information in FERC's eFiling system:

- CUL 1 Built Environment Technical Study Report
- CUL 2 Archaeology Technical Study Report
- TRI 1 Tribal Resources Technical Study Report

Because these documents include details on the locations of sensitive cultural and Tribal resources, they qualify as confidential information pursuant to 36 Code of Federal Regulations § 800.11(c)(1) and are being filed as privileged and confidential information. As such, SCE requests that FERC withhold these TSRs from public disclosure in accordance with applicable regulations.

The HPMP is still in development and will be filed separately when complete.
