For comparison, the current average mix of resources supplying SCE includes: Coal (0%), Nuclear (8.4%), Biomass & Waste (0.1%), Geothermal (5.5%), Solar (15.1%), Wind (9.4%), Natural Gas (15.2%), Eligible Hydroelectric (0.8%), Large Hydroelectric (3.3%), Unspecified Sources (42%) and Other (0.3%). This resource mix was prepared in accordance with the SCE 2020 Power Content Label.
