The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) will hold Evidentiary Hearings (EH's) regarding the proposed rate changes in the Application of Southern California Edison Company (SCE) To Establish Marginal Costs, Allocate Revenues, Design Rates and Implement Additional Dynamic Pricing Rates (A.11-06-007).

Any changes to the dates, times and locations of the EH's will be posted to the CPUC's Daily Calendar. The location for this hearing is wheelchair accessible. SCE's Application requests authority to revise retail rates for all of its customers, and to determine how SCE's revenues will be collected from residential, commercial, large business, and agricultural customer classes. While this application will not increase or decrease SCE's overall revenues, a number of other proceedings will conclude and result in changes to SCE's authorized revenues before the CPUC finishes its review of this application. The rate design the CPUC adopts in this proceeding will incorporate those revenue requirement changes. SCE anticipates that all of the issues in this proceeding will be addressed in settlement agreements that will be subject to CPUC approval. The evidentiary hearings will provide an opportunity for the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) and other parties to ask questions about the settlement agreements.

WHAT THIS MEANS TO YOU

The settlement agreements will modify the allocation of approved revenue requirements between the various customer classes. The changes are intended to better align rates with SCE's underlying cost to serve different classes of customers. Customer classes would see rate changes either greater than, or less than, SCE's system average increase.

EVIDENTIARY HEARINGS

The CPUC holds EH's whereby the formal parties of record provide testimony and are subject to cross-examination before the assigned CPUC Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). These hearings are open to the public to attend and listen, but only those who are formal parties of record are allowed to participate. One party is the Division of Ratepayer Advocates (DRA), which consists of engineers, accountants, economists and attorneys who independently evaluate the proposals of utilities and present their analyses and recommendations for the CPUC at the EH's. The CPUC has its own court reporters who will record the participation of parties in the EH's. Parties may participate, present testimony, cross-examine other parties' witnesses, and present oral arguments addressing the issues as set forth in the Joint Assigned Commissioner and ALJ's Ruling and Scoping Memo dated December 2, 2011. Parties may offer proposals that differ from those presented in SCE's application.

Evidentiary hearings will begin on September 20, 2012 at 10:00 a.m., and may continue on September 21, 2012, and on October 25, and 26, 2012 (if needed). The ALJ may modify the schedule at a later date, and will preside over the evidentiary hearings. The assigned Commissioner may be in attendance as well. The evidentiary hearings will be held at a designated CPUC hearing room in San Francisco, CA at the address noted above.

Once hearings are completed, the ALJ will consider all of the evidence presented and release a proposed decision. When the CPUC issues a final decision, it may adopt, amend or modify all or part of the ALJ's proposed decision. The final decision may differ from the requests filed by SCE in its application.
