



Agricultural and Pumping Interruptible Program (AP-I)

Boost Your Bottom Line With Year-Round Bill Credits



You may be able to enjoy monthly bill credits year-round when you participate in Southern California Edison's (SCE) Agricultural and Pumping Interruptible (AP-I) Program. Simply allow SCE to temporarily interrupt electric service during periods of peak energy demand and earn bill credits to lower your energy costs and help improve your bottom line.

The Savings Are Easy With AP-I

AP-I is available to agricultural and pumping customers with a measured demand of 37 kW or greater, or with at least 50 horsepower of connected load. As an AP-I participant, you must already be served under an eligible Agricultural and Pumping Rate Schedule, which includes Rate Schedule TOU-PA-ICE.*

Service Interruptions Are Limited and Automated For Ease

Upon notification from the California Independent System Operator (CAISO) of the need to implement energy load reductions in SCE's service territory, SCE will transmit a signal to the load control device installed on your pumping equipment, which will automatically turn off your total load served for the entire duration of the interruption or test event. AP-I customer load is controlled through SCE's remote-controlled switch only during interruption events. You will need to perform a manual reset of the main circuit

breaker or pump controller after each interruption or test event.

An interruption can occur at any time — 7 days a week, 365 days a year. Interruption events are limited to 6 hours per event, 25 events per calendar year, or 150 hours per calendar year.

Choose Your Preferred Method of Event Notification

As an AP-I participant, you may request courtesy notifications of interruption events, via automated phone messaging, text to cell phone, e-mail, fax and/or pager.**

Note: Use of any of the above courtesy services IS NOT a substitute for installing SCE's AP-I Control Device.





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Earn Monthly Bill Credits and Boost Your Bottom Line

The AP-I Program provides credits based on your current rate schedule:

1. For customers on Rate Schedule PA-1 or PA-2, the AP-I Program provides a per-kWh credit applied to the bill.
2. For customers on TOU rate schedules (for example, TOU-PA-3), the total credited amount will vary according to their average demand (kW) during time-of-use (TOU) periods.

Credit for Schedules PA-1 and PA-2		\$/kWh per Meter per Month
		\$(0.01102)
TOU Credit – Below 200 kW		\$/kWh per Meter per Month
Summer Average On-Peak		\$(16.27)
Summer Average Mid-Peak		\$(3.55)
Winter Average Mid-Peak		\$(1.27)
TOU Credit – 200 kW and Above		\$/kWh per Meter per Month
Summer Average On-Peak		\$(16.27)
Summer Average Mid-Peak		\$(3.55)
Winter Average Mid-Peak		\$(1.27)

Note: TOU-PA-SOP customers will receive AP-I credits based on Time-of-Use time periods.

Credit Calculations

Below is an example of the AP-I credit calculation for customers on Rate Schedule PA-1 or PA-2:

Customer's actual billing month kWh usage	Calculation	Credit applied to customer's bill for that month
15,000 kWh	$15,000 \text{ kWh} \times \$0.01102 = \$165.30$	(\$165.30)
An estimated annual savings of \$1,983.60.		

An example of the TOU rate credit calculation for a Summer On-Peak Period is:

Peak Period kWh					
Peak Period Hours	X	AP-I Factor	=	Peak Period Credit	
Summer On-Peak Period Example:					
• Total On-Peak Period kWh = 10,000					
• Total On-Peak Period Hours = 126					
• Applicable Peak Credit = Summer Average On-Peak (\$16.27)					
10,000 kWh					
126 Hours	X	(\$16.27)	=	(\$1,291.27)	





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Getting Started

Your SCE Account Manager can assist you with completing and submitting an enrollment contract into the AP-I Program. If you do not have a designated Account Manager, please call the AP-I Helpline at **1-800-206-9279**.

To enroll in AP-I, you'll need to:


- Designate the service account for participation,
- Sign and return the AP-I Contract for Interruptible Service for approval,
- Provide a suitable location for the installation of SCE's load control equipment, where it is accessible to SCE during business hours and/or reasonable hours, for maintenance and repairs; and
- Comply with all provisions within 30 days of contract execution.

For billing and participation purposes, your location is required to have interval meters capable of recording electricity use in 15-minute intervals.

AP-I is offered on a one-year contractual basis with changes or cancellations available during the one-month (November 1 – December 1) adjustment window.

Participate In Other Programs for Added Savings

With limitations, you may also participate in other demand response programs for additional incentives while participating in AP-I. For more information, please contact your SCE Account Manager, or visit **sce.com/drp**.
