

Typical Process

1. The process starts as soon as you begin working with your SCE Account Manager to review Pilot requirements and your proposed plans. Your Account Manager will discuss deployment considerations and options with you and work with you to fill out the **Application**.
2. Following an evaluation of your site and existing utility infrastructure, we will develop a proposal, including the potential number of DCFC stations and proposed location deployment at your site.
3. If you accept our proposal based on your Application and our meetings with you, and program funds are still available, we will prepare the Agreement for you to sign. You will then provide Proof of Purchase of the qualifying DCFC stations within 30 days after funding is reserved and participation is confirmed in accordance with the terms of the proposal you accepted.
4. You will also be required to provide a notarized Easement Agreement signed by the property owner to grant certain rights to SCE and to secure the infrastructure we will deploy at your site.
5. We'll complete and present the deployment design to you. Once you approve the design (after we receive proof of purchase), we will apply for construction permits.
6. After construction permits are issued, we will deploy the electric infrastructure and arrange for inspection. The charging station installation vendor(s) you select will install the charging stations (after obtaining any applicable permits on your behalf to authorize the installation of the charging station with the electric infrastructure we deployed) and arrange for inspection. Note that you must have your charging stations installed within 20 days after the electric infrastructure is deployed.
7. Following installation of the charging stations, we will conduct a walk-through to verify that the deployment is consistent with approved plans. Finally, if everything is deployed as agreed upon, you will receive notification that the project is complete, and we will process the rebate payment.
