Pre-Application Document Overview / Technical Study Plan Development Webinar

On December 16, 2021, Southern California Edison Company (SCE) filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) its Notice of Intent (NOI) to file an Application for New License and Pre-Application Document (PAD) for the Rush Creek Project (Project), FERC Project No. 1389.
