## Updates for 2016

- The rebate for purchasing and installing a qualifying Variable Speed Pool Pump and motor will remain at \$200 for each qualified installation
- Limits apply, see page 1 of the **2016 HEER Information Sheet**

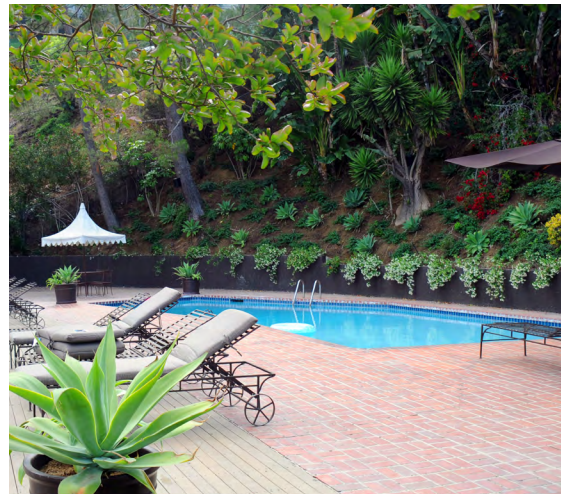
## New for 2016

Contractors are now eligible to submit invoices on behalf of their customers by completing the second part of Step 1 of the **Mail-in Application**.

- Be sure to obtain consent and acknowledgement from your customer before proceeding
- \$300 Variable Speed Pool Pump PRP Promotion ended December 31, 2015. For a limited time we offered a rebate of \$300 to installs completed in the Preferred Resources Pilot (PRP) Region. This promotional incentive ended
- The contractor/installer incentive for installing a qualified Variable Speed Pool Pump and motor will remain at \$100 for each qualifying installation. Remember to set pumps to run Off-Peak\* to receive this incentive. We will continue to conduct Multiple Random Inspections to confirm pumps are set to run Off-Peak
- If you completed the Foundation for Pool and Spa Industry Education (FPSIE) Pool Installer Certification Program for the Rebate Program in 2014 or 2015, your certification is valid until December 31, 2017, unless otherwise stated

## About the Incentive Process

- There is no annual limit to how many \$100 incentives you can receive
- If you fail three inspections you will be removed from our list of qualified contractors/installers, and you will no longer be eligible to receive \$100 incentives until the following calendar year, or until the FPSIE CAEI course is retaken

### 2016 Instructions to Receive \$100 Pool Contractor Incentives

1. Install a qualifying Variable Speed Pool Pump and set it to operate Off-Peak
2. Provide your customer with an invoice displaying your company information and a unique invoice number
3. Ensure your customer applies for the Variable Speed Pool Pump Rebate online at [www.sce.com/rebates](http://www.sce.com/rebates)
  - Your customer must have an active SCE service account, and must include a copy of your invoice as proof of purchase with their rebate via email, fax or mail
  - Your customers can send their proof of purchases via email to [EE.Processing.Center@SCE.com](mailto:EE.Processing.Center@SCE.com). Please ask them to include the CRM application number in the subject line
  - All terms and conditions listed on the **Online HEER Form** must be met in order for the rebate to be processed

### How We Process Contractor Incentives

When we process your customer's application, we will match the proof of purchase (invoice) submitted by the customer to your company information received by FPSIE. If all required documentation is complete and accurate, and the inspection confirms the pump is a Variable Speed that is set to operate Off-Peak, we will mail you a \$100 check for each application within 4-6 weeks.

Please note, we cannot provide you with the name of any customer who submits a rebate application. It will be your sole responsibility to verify with your customers that they have submitted their HEER Rebate Application accompanied by your invoice.

To avoid any delays in receiving your incentive, make sure all contractor/installer contact information submitted to FPSIE is accurate. Contact FPSIE for any changes or updates.
